@ Madera County Old Timers' Day Parade

Application: All pages must be completed. Only and all food vendors must complete the Concessionaire Health Permit Application.

Event Details:

This year marks the 91st anniversary of the Old Timers' Day Parade! A 14-foot steel beam salvaged from the World Trade Center attacks will lead this year's parade. Following the parade, a groundbreaking ceremony will be held in Courthouse Park, serving as the beam's final resting place. Every year, thousands of people gather in Madera, California for the Old Timers' Day Parade. During and after, our guests like to enjoy the variety of foods and park activities at the Park.

Any club, church, service organization, business, or other organization may apply to participate in Booths in the Park at the Madera County Courthouse Park on Saturday, September 24th, 2022 from 8 am - 3 pm. Booth space will be available for applicants who will be able to sell foods, soft drinks, novelty items, arts and crafts, or distribute approved information.

Fees:

- **Standard booth space:** Forty Dollars (\$40.00).
- **Political booths:** Seventy-Five dollars (\$75.00).
- **Rain Insurance:** Ten dollars (\$10.00). *(if it rains enough to impact the event, your entire fee would be refunded, including the insurance fee)*
- **Food Vendor Operations Food Permit:** One hundred & Twenty Nine dollars (\$129)
 - *Non-Profits and Veterans may be exempt from this fee (see the Concessionaire Health Permit application for details)*
- **Checks made payable to *Madera Young Professionals***

Booth Space Details:

- Space location will be assigned approximately one week before the event. All approved applicants will receive a site map validating their location.
- Electrical outlets are limited so most spaces do not have power. These spaces will be prioritized for applicants serving consumable items. (Power is not guaranteed)
- Standard Booth space size is 10 x 10.
 - Exceptions can be made for food vendors.
 - Non-Food vendors may be required to pay for two spaces if the space is needed.
